1. There is a state-owned carpentry on Ulica Browarna at Legnica (Liegnitz), known as Spoldzielnia Odbudowy. It employs about 70 workers and makes folding beds, closets, chairs, and tables, all for the army. An order for 3,000 folding beds was received in July 1951. The carpentry is fully mechanized.
2. Legnica has two large industrial enterprises: a ready-made clothing factory which employs 1,600 women in two shifts, and a factory which produces tanks; the latter is located near the railroad track. The tank factory was built by the Germans and is now Soviet property. The entire labor force consists of Soviet soldiers.
3. There was practically no building at Legnica during 1951. A certain number of buildings were demolished and the bricks salvaged and sent to Warsaw.
